



Guy Emanuele Sports Fund Scholarship 2010-2011 Fall, Winter and Spring Sports

Financial support grants are offered to Fremont Unified School District high school students who wish to participate in after-school sports and cheerleading, but need assistance to offset the cost of equipment, sportswear, transportation costs, tournament fees, and other related items required for participation.

The Fremont Education Foundation (FEF) is proud to offer the ***Guy Emanuele Sports Fund Scholarship***, named after the fund's founder Guy Emanuele. This scholarship may be awarded for up to \$200 per individual grant recipient, funds permitting. Grants are not awarded to offset the cost of the \$50 sports donation, or Boosters' fee. Grants are not awarded for students who receive other grants or reimbursements from any other organizations (including Boosters) that pay or offset the student's cost for items covered by this grant. A student may receive more than one grant if participating in different sports seasonally. Whether a grant is awarded and the amounts of such grants, if any, are completely within the discretion of the Fremont Education Foundation.

The Fremont Education Foundation (“FEF”) is proud to offer the Guy Emanuele Sports Fund (“GESF”), named after its founder Guy Emanuele, providing grants to Fremont Unified School District students who wish to participate in after-school sports, but who lack the financial means to do so. The GESF grant is intended to offset some of the student’s costs for equipment, sportswear, transportation costs, fees, shoes, sports bags, tournament fees, and other related items required for participation. FEF is currently able to award up to \$200 per grant recipient, funds permitting. Grants are not awarded to offset the cost of the \$50 sports donation or Booster fee as these are not mandatory to play after-school sports. Grants are not awarded for students who receive other grants or reimbursements from any other organizations (including Boosters) that pay or offset the student’s costs for items covered by this grant. A student may receive more than one GESF grant if participating in different sports seasonally. Whether GESF grants are awarded, and the amounts of such grants, if any, are completely within the discretion of FEF.
